**THS 600 Theological Foundations**

**Description:** This course sets the foundations for pursuing the discipline of theology. A brief look at fundamental theology examines the notions of faith and revelation. Various methods of theological reflection are surveyed, using illustrations from classic and contemporary theologians. Attention is given to the use of Scripture, tradition, human experience, and reason in the quest to understand and present the Christian faith. Students will learn sources and methods for theological research.

**Purpose of the Course:** This course is designed to orient students within the discipline of theology and equip them with the tools necessary to do theological research throughout the M.A. program and their careers.
